



## **Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033 – Adoption Statement**

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

Notice of Adoption of the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033

In accordance with the above regulations notice is hereby given that the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033 was adopted by Buckinghamshire Council as a Development Plan Document on the 15th September 2021.

The Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033 was submitted to Secretary of State on 28 February 2018 and was subject to an independent examination conducted by Paul Clark MA(Oxon) MA(TRP) MRTPI MCMI, an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report concluded that, with the recommended main modifications set out, the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan satisfies the requirements of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and meets the criteria for soundness in the National Planning Policy Framework. The recommended main modifications have been included in the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033, which now carries full weight in the consideration of planning applications. The full list of main modifications made to the plan following receipt of the Inspector's Report is set out in the 'Schedule of Recommended Main Modifications', published as an Appendix to the Inspector's Report. A number of additional modifications have also been included as necessary technical, factual, grammatical and typographical corrections that do not materially affect the policies in the plan.

In accordance with the regulations the following documents have been made available:

- the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033 (adoption version);
- the Policies Map;
- this Adoption Statement;
- the Sustainability Appraisal Report; and
- the Sustainability Appraisal Adoption Statement.

Any person aggrieved by the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan 2013-2033 may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made no later than six weeks after the publication of this adoption statement, which is the 27<sup>th</sup> October 2021.
