### **PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT** **TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES** **CASTLEFIELD AREA - HIGH WYCOMBE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 90A – 90F of the Highways Act 1980, The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 and after consultation with the Chief of Police, proposes to construct traffic calming measures across several roads in the Castlefield Area of High Wycombe.

The proposed traffic calming measures consist of asphalt raised tables and junctions of a maximum height of 100mm and bolt-down performed speed cushions of a maximum height of 75mm, at the locations below:

Booker Lane adjacent to the shops	Reconstruction of full-width raised table	2.5m long with slopes at 1:10
Whitelands Road adjacent to No's: 136, 122, 116, 94, 80, 62 & 48	Preformed cushions	3.0m long, 1.6m wide

These Traffic Calming measures are designed to improve the safety of pedestrians and other road users through the Castlefield Area and to limit and deter anti-social driving behaviours, with motorists encouraged to approach at a slower speed.
