# **Information Statement: Mursley Neighbourhood Plan Referendum**



A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held for the Mursley Neighbourhood Plan on **Wednesday 6 March 2024**.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is:

'Do you want Buckinghamshire Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Mursley to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

The referendum area and the neighbourhood plan areas cover the same area as the parish of Mursley (see map below).

#### You can vote in the referendum if the following apply:

- You live in the parish of Mursley.
- You are registered to vote in local council elections, or you register to vote by Monday 19 February 2024. You can check if you are registered to vote by calling 01296 798141 or emailing elections@buckinghamshire.gov.uk
- You are 18 years of age or over on Wednesday 6 March 2024
- When voting in person, you have a valid form of ID. To see which types of ID are valid or to get an ID for this referendum visit: https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photoid-voter-authority-certificate

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections.



## **Expense Limits**

The expense limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is 2,362 + (567x£0.059) = £2,395.45. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 567.
